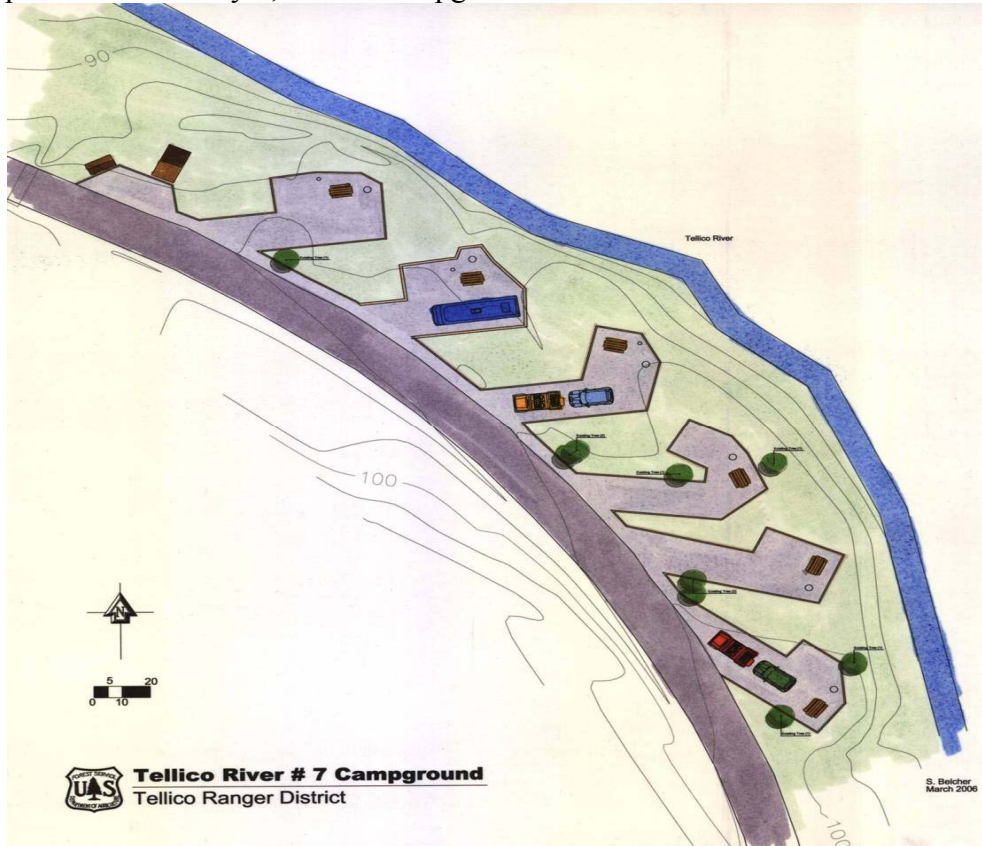

Subject: Tellico River Campground #7 Temporarily Closed

To: Forest Users

As of April 25, 2006 Tellico River Campground #7 is closed for at least 2 months due to construction at the site. The Cherokee National Forest has initiated a series of projects to improve the recreation facilities within the Tellico River corridor. This project will enhance the camping experience for all Forest users and will allow the Forest Service to provide and maintain camping and bathroom facilities that are safe, sanitary, and protect the natural resources of the Tellico River corridor.

Campground #7 will be modified to include 6 accessible sites, each with a picnic table, fire ring, and lantern post (see drawing below). Each site will have a 5 person and 2 vehicle limit. An accessible single vault toilet and bear-proof trash cans will be installed. A \$10/night/site user fee will be implemented January 1, 2007. Campground #7 will be renamed Holder Cove.
